GENERAL INFORMATION

1. An exhibition of outdoor and indoor sculpture with scope for installations and site-specific works. Please note that indoor works must be free standing. We are unable to attach works to the walls, but have the capacity to suspend from the ceiling.
2. THERE IS ATWO ENTRY LIMIT PER SCULPTOR. Late entries will not be accepted.
3. Exhibits must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition.
4. The artist agrees to images, extracts from artist's statements and CVs being used for exhibition publicity purposes.
5. The awards and prize money may change subject to funding and current sponsorship negotiations.

SELECTION

6. The selection panel will determine successful entries, and all artists will be notified by Friday 5 August.
7. The decision of the selection panel will be final with no further correspondence entered into.
8. All work must be original and available for sale.
9. The committee reserves the right to withdraw or relocate any entry deemed unsuitable or dangerous to the public, prior to and during the exhibition, after consultation with the artist. Finalists will be required to sign a conditions and terms of agreement form.
10. CVs, photographs, jpeg images, *and an installation safety plan where applicable* must be included with the Entry Form. Works currently in progress are acceptable for consideration with support material.
11. The artist's statement (50 words maximum) to be included with the Entry Form. This will appear in the catalogue.

IMPORTANT DATES

12. The exhibition will show from **Sunday 13 October until Sunday 8 December 2019 inclusively.**
13. Installation dates will be strictly **9.00 am – 5.00 pm, Monday 30 September and Tuesday 1 October 2019.**
14. Collection dates will be strictly **9.00 am – 5.00 pm Monday 9 December and Tuesday 10 December, 2019**
15. Opening and awards presentation will occur on **Sunday 13 October at 2.00 pm** in Yering Station's historic barn.

INSTALLATION & DELIVERY

16. Sculptors will take responsibility for the installation and public safety of their work. Finalists are welcome to book an appointment to discuss the placement and installation of their work.
17. The artist is also responsible for delivery, installation costs, and any associated insurance costs.
18. On delivery each exhibit must be clearly labeled indicating name of sculptor, title of work, medium, dimensions, sculptor's phone number and sale price.

FEES

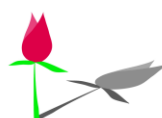
19. A non-refundable administrative entry fee of **\$45 PER ENTRY** is required (money order payable to *Yarra Valley Arts* or transfer funds directly to The Yarra Valley Arts Council Inc. BSB 633 000 Acc. No. 151 010 147. Please use family name and first initial as a reference)
20. A commission of 30% will be charged on all works sold (20% is donated to LARCH – Leukaemia Auxiliary of the Royal Children's Hospital, while the remaining 10% is forwarded to Yarra Valley Arts to promote and support their Arts Program).
21. The selling price as indicated on the confirmation form will be the catalogue price. The organizing committee will not be held responsible for any discrepancies.

SECURITY

22. There is a security patrol at Yering Station twice nightly however the exhibition organizers hold no insurance against damage or burglary of works. Public Liability insurance is covered by the exhibition.
23. The exhibition does not have an accidental / malicious damage insurance policy and artists are advised to individually insure their works against damage and theft. This is not a traditional gallery situation, and although we do our best to safeguard artworks some people will invariably touch. Please speak with the curator if you have any installation queries.

DEINSTALLATION & CONCLUSION OF EXHIBITION

24. If the artist wishes an agent to collect their work authorization must be in writing to the curator.
25. Artists will be responsible for the delivery of sold work to a radius of 100km from Yering Station or arrangement thereof with the purchaser.
26. Payment by electronic funds transfer for sale of exhibits will occur within six weeks of the purchaser's final payment.
